Minutes

Complaint

A complaint has been made against the committee and has been investigated by the Welfare Officer. Learning point for the committee is for any communications over concerns with members is to be done via email, or if being done over phone this is after notification to the member and another committee member being made aware.

Wednesday Nights

A recent decision was made by the committee over restarting KADS Wednesday nights. All committee members were okay with how this was made but felt that there had been some missed communication.

There had been some feedback from run leaders about how the Wednesday night has been brought together as they feel that the ratio of run leaders to members wasn't accurate. They will be happy to continue to help with the structured sessions but have since left the run leader whatsapp group. Concerns over risk assessment and public perception had also been raised but these have been answered by the Covid Officer.

All agreed to give it a couple of weeks to see how uptake is, there could be various reasons as to why it hasn't had a quick uptake.

Next week there could be a smaller structured session alongside the club night and the week after is track night.

AGM

The idea would be to hold the AGM over Microsoft Teams as there are good presentation options on this.

Reports would be sent out to members ahead of time so they have chance to read them.

Committee role descriptions and who wants to go for the roles would be published, so if there is the chance for people to stand. A voting system needs to be developed to help with this. The committee has to be Chairperson, Treasurer and Secretary and no more than 7 other roles.

AGM date - 2nd Dec

This allows 21 days notice, with 1 week for giving role descriptions and 1 week for voting.

Kit

Usually at AGM the kit book is usually open for future sales but as it will be held virtually this year, it will still open but via email. Books will open when notification goes out for the date of the AGM.

Big Bobble Hat company allows for custom colours and KADS logo, there isn't room for profit in this. 20 hats would be £18 +VAT. Interest will be gauged to find out if there is enough to look into it further.

Social Activities
